With regular trains seven days a week, the Maritime Line is great for all kinds of trips whether for work, school, shopping, exploring the countryside or connecting at Truro to the rest of the country.

In this leaflet you will find the current timetable and information about places to visit, fares and the recent local celebrations which took place to celebrate 150 years of the line.

Off Peak Day Return

These tickets are available Monday to Friday after the morning peak and at anytime weekends and Bank Holidays.

GroupSave

GroupSave allows groups of three or four people to travel together for the price of two adult Off Peak Day Returns on the Maritime Line and other First Great Western services.

Ride Cornwall Ticket

You can enjoy unlimited travel on most bus and all train services throughout Cornwall with just this one ticket! The ticket also includes travel to Plymouth and is valid after 09 00 on weekdays, anytime at weekends.

A Ride Cornwall ticket costs £10 adult, £7.50 child or you can buy a family ticket for £20 (up to 2 adults and 3 children). Tickets can be bought at railway stations, from the guard on the train or bus conductor.

Freedom of Devon and Cornwall Rover

Enjoy unlimited off-peak train travel in both counties. Available for 3 in 7 days £45 adult, or 8 in 15 days £69.00 adult.

Travel to work by train

Season tickets offer great discounts if you use the Maritime Line daily to commute to work.

Seven Day Season rates

Falmouth Town - Truro	£15.70
Penmere - Truro	£14.70
Penryn - Truro	£12.50
Penryn - Falmouth Town	£8.00

Seven Day Season tickets offer unlimited travel between the two stations for seven days, allowing leisure as well as work trips. They can be bought from the Conductor on the train.

Season tickets are also available for periods of between one month and a year, offering better discounts still. Longer period Season tickets need to be bought at Truro or another staffed station.

A yearly ticket gives twelve weeks' free travel and is also a Devon & Cornwall Gold Card which gives discounts on off peak travel in the two counties.

Great Value Days out by Train

Penzance

Nestled in Mounts Bay, Penzance offers a great day out. It has plenty of history and has been a market town since 1592.



There is a wide range of shops within a short distance of the railway station which range from national chains to smaller independent retailers. There are also plenty of little cafes and restaurants to enjoy lunch or afternoon tea.

St Ives

There can be no doubt that the best way to arrive into St Ives is by train.



The views are stunning from the moment you leave St Erth as the line sweeps alongside the golden sands of Hayle Towans, then hugs the cliffs as it passes through Carbis Bay and on to St Ives itself.

Porthminster Beach is right next to the station whilst the town centre and harbour are just a short pleasant walk away.
